


Primary Motivation...

WHERE YOU FIND JOY IN LIFE ~

THIS IS ALSO THE FUEL OF YOUR LIFE

How you are motivated to find joy in your life is a very personal thing. It's different for every one of us, but what *is* the same for every one of us is that we all have this "primary motivation": a constant drive or need to find joy in life. Your Primary Motivation is like a software program that



runs your life 24 hours/day, 7 days/week, and this runs your entire life. This is one of the ways spirit animates us.

Understanding and taking responsibility for your own Primary Motivation in this life time has never been more important. This helps you to better understand and discern the difference between the illusions of your own world and the inspiration of your own world, and when I say your own world, I am speaking to you in your individual capacity. Get to know the true source of the energy fueling your life, then you will know what your true motives are, what is motivating you, what animates you to do and think and say, what you do. In understanding that, then you'll know who you truly are. This is a magnificent opportunity of healing, quick shifting. You will be highly amused at times to catch the false and fake aspects of yourself trying to trick you into getting hooked up into the 4th dimension again, the astral plane, where malevolence reigns.

So, what is the quality of life you believe you deserve?" The Law of Resonance will bring us what we resonate with: it has all to do with vibration. Start fresh and brand new. Focus on the self instead of asserting ourselves in others' lives, providing unsolicited advice or healing suggestions as these are examples of our own Primary Motivation unsatisfied: We begin looking for an outlet to be satisfied outside of ourselves. We must honor everyone's paths and their free will by remembering to respond to requests for assistance vs. assuming they need us and "we know what they need." We serve by living our lives and leading by example.

Through reflection and introspection, one can realize what is motivating them, but the majority of humanity does not understand what motivates them, or they may be so entrenched in their own habits, they can't see the forest for the trees. In addition, many are in a current state of dis-empowerment; therefore, they cannot trust their own intuition.

Wouldn't it be great to find out what your Primary Motivation is in this life?

To find that personal joy?

Using the tools and techniques of Medieval Astrology, a diploma course created by Robert E. Zoller, there is a process that by using the element and the other ruling planets of one's Rising Sign (also known as the Ascendant), this can be explained. Furthermore, you also have a roadmap to actually realize your Primary Motivation in your life! *(It should be noted that although this is not part of the actual history of Medieval Astrology, Robert learned this technique from his professor and thought it was so significant and of such great benefit, that he has included it in his course. I remember how taken back I was when we were taught this technique, and ever since, I've wanted to provide this as a service for others.)*

Using the information in the table I created below starts the framework of your Primary Motivation by creating a sentence, which is based on the sign's element:

PRIMARY MOTIVATION		
Masculine	Fire Sign: Aries, Leo, Sagittarius	Drive for freedom of action
Masculine	Air Sign: Gemini, Libra, Aquarius	Drive for freedom of movement and freedom of expression
Feminine	Water Sign: Cancer, Scorpio, Pisces	Need for emotional security
Feminine	Earth Sign: Taurus, Virgo, Capricorn	Need for physical security

- 1) To use this, you'd need to know your Rising Sign (your Ascendant).
- 2) Check the table above for your Rising Sign, and you'll see the element it is associated with.
- 3) Your Primary Motivation sentence example would read in one of the four ways listed below:

Fire sign (Aries, Leo, Sagittarius): Your Primary Motivation is the drive for freedom of action, which you will attempt to realize through *(insert the planet here that rules your Fire sign, and insert the sign and house the planet is in.)*

Air sign (Gemini, Libra, Aquarius): Your Primary Motivation is the drive for freedom of movement and freedom of expression, which you will attempt to realize through *(insert the planet here that rules your Air sign, and insert the sign and house the planet is in.)*

Water sign (Cancer, Scorpio, Pisces): Your Primary Motivation is the need for emotional security, which you will attempt to realize through (*insert the planet here that rules your Water sign, and insert the sign and house that planet is in.*)

Earth sign (Taurus, Virgo, Capricorn): Your Primary Motivation is the need for physical security, which you will attempt to realize through (*insert the planet here that rules your Earth sign, and insert the sign and house that planet is in.*)

If you'd like to know more and would consider having a Primary Motivation session, we would:

--Consider what this sentence means to you first because first and foremost: not everyone has a planet that would deliver on the promise to bring you joy in life! This is another reason why it's key to really focus on your reading because for the first time ever. However, we are being given the opportunity to rise above our limitations, to transcend our Primary Motivation. For people like me (my ruling planet is in detriment, it couldn't deliver on its promise to bring me joy in life), this is a HUGE opportunity—it is for all of us!! Secondly, your ascendant contains a tremendous amount of insight and information. It's your 1st House, which is YOU: it describes your nature, your skills, talents, wit, charm, and your body. Consider this your God-given talents.

--Then, we'd look at the planetary rulers associated with Medieval astrology techniques.

--Next we'd look at other planets within the first house (if there are any).

--Lastly, we'd look at the aspects to your Rising Sign (if there are any).

This additional information provides insight as to other dynamics that may have manifested in your life that may also have been paths to bring you joy. Some may have been more beneficial than others. You may have felt scattered in life or the priorities may have changed during certain times in your life. These planets will continue to attempt to realize your Primary Motivation and bring additional qualities to you personally.

Truly and fully understanding your Primary Motivation is extremely important as it is key to understanding one's motivation in life which fuels and flavors all other areas in one's life, especially the four "main" pillars of life:

- 1) The first pillar is YOU, as described above; it's your 1st House. Your wit, talent, charm, body, etc. In addition to understanding this first pillar is the keen awareness of how it is that you give and receive of yourself and the quality of that giving and receiving: is it done out of love, misplaced service (did you assume they wanted your help?), and is how you're giving of yourself done out of habit/routine, or is it done out of resentment? Are you able to receive in love—mostly people are great at giving (even to their detriment) but cannot receive in joy. Your ability to give/receive from love is the foundation from which the rest of your life is built. This is why Primary Motivation is extremely important to understand more than ever with zero tolerance for lack in this new world. Then, after YOU, are the next three main pillars in life which are:
- 2) Home/Family, your 4th House
- 3) Partnerships/Relationships, your 7th House
- 4) Career/Work/Creativity, your actions in the world, your 10th House

If you try to skip the first pillar, which is 1) YOU (being balanced in giving/receiving), and go to one of the other 3 pillars to make changes, like changing your job or career, the positive changes you wish to see in your career won't happen. They can't because you haven't addressed your foundation: you!

When you truly know yourself, there's a love of self that begins to bloom, and inner peace unfolds. It becomes a steady foundation from which you connect to your divine essence within, trusting your intuition, and deepening your faith.

Understanding your original blueprint (your natal chart) is a wonderfully empowering manner in which you can be your true and authentic self, using the Divine gifts you intended to bring forth in this life time. "(Wo)Man Know Thyself."

Focus on your heart, your purity, and your intention of your spirit.
